Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 864 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on January 7, 2008, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 864 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-02, and a \$50 late filing fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 11,063, served January 7, 2008. In addition, respondent was directed to file a new tariff because the preexisting tariff was no longer effective.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on January 9, 2008, tendered \$50 cash for the insurance late fee on January 22, 2008, and filed an acceptable tariff on March 12, 2008. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
