Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 401 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on April 11, 2008, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 401 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$50 late filing fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 11,266, served April 14, 2008.

The order also noted that respondent had neither filed a 2008 annual report nor paid the \$150 annual fee for 2008 and that under Regulation No. 67-03 respondent therefore also owed an additional \$200 in late fees.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement and tendered a \$50 money order on April 11, 2008. Respondent also filed a 2008 Annual Report, paid the \$150 annual fee, and paid the \$200 in late filing fees on April 14, 2008. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
