By letter dated March 28, 2008, applicant was directed to publish notice of its application for a certificate of authority in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District no later than April 11, 2008, and file an affidavit of publication no later than April 25, 2008. Applicant also had until April 11 to submit evidence in support of its temporary authority application. Applicant has yet to respond.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain operating authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³ Because applicant has failed to comply with the Commission's application requirements, the applications shall be dismissed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the applications of Capital Transportation, Inc., for temporary authority and a certificate of authority are hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
