Case No. AP-2008-097

Certificate No. 919 was terminated at applicant's request in Order No. 11,383, served May 30, 2008, pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(b), of the Compact. Respondent thereafter filed a request seeking reinstatement.

Under Article XIII, Section 4(a) of the Compact, a party to a proceeding affected by a final order or decision of the Commission may file within 30 days of its publication a written application requesting Commission reconsideration of the matter involved, and stating specifically the errors claimed as grounds for reconsideration.

Applicant timely filed its request for reinstatement as of June 20, 2008, but the application does not allege any error on the part of the Commission. The application therefore is denied.

However, considering that an effective tariff and an effective \$1.5 million WMATC Insurance Endorsement are on file for applicant, and were on file as of June 20, 2008, we will reopen this proceeding on our own initiative and reinstate Certificate of Authority No. 919.¹
