This matter is before the Commission on respondent's failure to respond to Order No. 11,185, served March 3, 2008, which gave respondent thirty days to comply with the Commission's regulations governing insurance, tariffs, annual reports, annual fees, and late fees or face revocation of Certificate No. 429.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on March 3, 2008, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 429 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$50 late fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 11,185. The order also noted that respondent did not have an effective tariff on file and that respondent still owed a 2008 annual report, a \$150 annual fee, and another \$200 in associated late fees.

Accordingly, the order gave respondent thirty days to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s), submit a new tariff, submit a 2008 annual report, and pay the sum of \$400, or show cause why Certificate No. 429 should not be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

Respondent has yet to respond. Certificate No. 429 therefore shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact. All outstanding fees and reports shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 429 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 429 to the Commission.
