Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 189 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million primary and \$4 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated on July 1, 2008, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 189 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$50 late fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 11,450, served July 1, 2008.

Respondent filed acceptable \$1 million primary and \$4 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on August 1, 2008 and tendered \$50 cash on September 5, 2008. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
