This matter is before the Commission on applicant's request for an extension of time to comply with the conditions of the grant of authority in Commission Order No. 11,116, served January 29, 2008.

Order No. 11,116 specified that applicant would have the full 180 days available under Commission Regulation No. 66 to satisfy the conditions of the grant. Applicant did not fully comply with the prescribed conditions within the allotted time. The conditional grant consequently became void on July 28, 2008. Under Article XIII, Section 4(a), applicant had until August 28, 2008, to file an application for reconsideration.<sup>1</sup>

Instead of filing an application for reconsideration, applicant filed a request for an extension of time on August 28, 2008. Even if we were to treat this as a request for reconsideration, the request does not allege any error on the part of the Commission as required by statute.<sup>2</sup> However, considering that applicant fully satisfied the conditions of the grant as of August 28, we will reopen this proceeding on our own initiative<sup>3</sup> and issue Certificate of Authority No. 1488.<sup>4</sup>

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Certificate of Authority No. 1488 shall be issued to Management Support Technology, Incorporated, 9990 Fairfax Boulevard, #300, Fairfax, VA, 22030.
