Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1488 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million primary and \$10 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements currently on file for respondent were filed by fax on August 28, 2008. Under Regulation No. 58-06, a faxed endorsement must be replaced by the original within fifteen days, or it will be revoked pursuant to Regulation No. 58-09. Respondent has yet to file the originals of the faxes filed August 28. Accordingly, the WMATC Endorsements filed by fax on August 28, 2008, shall be revoked.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That respondent's \$1 million primary and \$10 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements are hereby revoked, effective thirty days from the date of this order.

2. That Certificate No. 1488 shall be automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and subject to revocation pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact, if respondent fails to file the necessary replacement WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) within thirty days.
