This matter is before the Commission on the request of respondent for an extension of time to comply with Order No. 11,639, served October 24, 2008, which assessed a combined civil forfeiture of \$9,500 against respondent for transporting passengers for hire between points in the Metropolitan District while Certificate No. 1056 was suspended and for failing to comply with a Commission order. Order No. 11,639 suspended all but \$2,250 of the forfeiture on the condition that respondent pay the net forfeiture within thirty days.

Respondent tendered a \$500 money order on November 21 and has requested a ninety day extension to pay the remainder of the net forfeiture in three installments.

Considering that respondent has made a good faith effort to comply with Order No. 11,639, the request shall be granted.¹ Respondent may pay the remaining \$1,750 in two installments of \$600 each and one installment of \$550. The first two shall be due on the first of January 2009 and the first of February 2009, respectively. The third shall be due on the first of March 2009.
