Certificate No. 848 has been suspended since November 21, 2008, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 11,701, served November 21, 2008, noted that Certificate No. 848 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$50 late fee within thirty days. Respondent has yet to file an acceptable insurance endorsement¹ and pay the late fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 848 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

The \$50 late fee shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 848 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 848 to the Commission.
