Certificate No. 618 has been suspended since November 28, 2008, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 11,718, served December 1, 2008, noted that Certificate No. 618 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$50 late fee within thirty days. Respondent has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the late fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 618 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

The \$50 late fee shall remain due. To prevent circumvention of Regulation Nos. 60-01 and 67-02, respondent's 2009 annual report and 2009 annual fee shall be due in the event Certificate No. 618 is reinstated in 2009.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 618 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
  - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
  - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
  - c. surrender Certificate No. 618 to the Commission.
