Certificate No. 1237 was automatically suspended on December 20, 2008, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 11,765, served December 22, 2008, in Case No. MP-2008-256, noted that Certificate No. 1237 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$50 late fee within thirty days. Respondent paid the \$50 late fee by company check and filed an application requesting voluntary termination of Certificate No. 1237 on January 16, 2009.

The Commission may terminate a certificate of authority under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 10(b), upon application by the holder. If appearing respondent is in good standing, the application for voluntary termination shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1237 is hereby terminated, effective this date.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order applicant shall:
  - a. remove from applicant's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
  - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
  - c. surrender Certificate No. 1237 to the Commission.
