Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1160 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on February 18, 2009, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 1160 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$50 late filing fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 11,849, served February 18, 2009.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on Feb 23, 2009 and tendered a \$50 company check on March 2, 2009. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
