Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1398 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum. Under Regulation No. 67-03(c), \$50 is due and payable upon the failure of a carrier to timely file an acceptable WMATC Insurance Endorsement.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent expired on April 3, 2009, and has not been replaced. Certificate No. 1398, therefore, is automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12 and may be revoked if respondent fails to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) and pay the \$50 late fee within thirty days.

In addition, respondent owes a 2009 annual report pursuant to Regulation No. 60-01, a \$150 2009 annual fee pursuant to Regulation No. 67-02, and \$200 in late fees pursuant to Regulation No. 67-03(a),(b) for failing to file the annual report and pay the annual fee on or before February 2, 2009.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That respondent shall not transport passengers for hire under Certificate No. 1398, unless and until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

2. That within thirty days, respondent shall file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s), submit a 2009 annual report, and pay by money order, certified check, or cashier's check the sum of \$400, or show cause why Certificate No. 1398 should not be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.
