Certificate No. 239 has been suspended since March 13, 2009, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 11,886, served March 13, 2009, noted that Certificate No. 239 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$50 late fee within thirty days. Respondent has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the late fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 239 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

In addition to the \$50 late insurance fee, respondent owes a 2009 annual report pursuant to Regulation No. 60-01, a \$150 2009 annual fee pursuant to Regulation No. 67-02, and \$200 in late fees pursuant to Regulation No. 67-03(a), (b) for failing to file the annual report and pay the annual fee on or before February 2, 2009.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 239 is hereby revoked.
2. That respondent's 2009 annual report, \$150 2009 annual fee, and \$250 in late fees shall remain due.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 239 to the Commission.
