Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1284 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary and \$3.5 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated on April 1, 2009, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 1284 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$50 late filing fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 11,905, served April 1, 2009.

In addition, respondent owed an annual report for 2009 pursuant to Regulation No. 60-01, a \$150 annual fee for 2009 pursuant to Regulation No. 67-02, and \$200 in late fees pursuant to Regulation No. 67-03(a),(b) for failing to file the annual report and pay the annual fee on or before February 2, 2009.¹

Respondent tendered a 2009 annual report and a \$350 money order on April 28, 2009. Respondent later filed acceptable \$2 million primary and \$3 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on May 27, 2009, and tendered a \$50 money order on June 3, 2009. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
