Certificate No. 1395 was automatically suspended on May 5, 2009, pursuant to Regulation Nos. 60-03 and 67-04, as a result of respondent's failure to file an annual report for 2009 pursuant to Regulation No. 60-01, pay a \$150 annual fee for 2009 pursuant to Regulation No. 67-02, and pay \$200 in associated late fees pursuant to Regulation No. 67-03(a), (b). Order No. 11,970, served May 8, 2009, gave respondent thirty days to file the annual report, pay the \$150 annual fee, and pay the \$200 in late fees.

Certificate No. 1395 was additionally suspended on June 1, 2009, pursuant to Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$50 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), when the \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated without replacement. Order No. 12,020, served June 2, 2009, gave respondent thirty days to file the necessary WMATC Endorsement(s) and pay the \$50 late insurance fee.

Both orders stipulated that Certificate No. 1395 would be subject to revocation upon respondent's failure to timely comply. Respondent has complied with neither order.

Although respondent still has time to comply with Order No. 12,020, Certificate No. 1395 shall be revoked at this time pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with Regulation Nos. 60 and 67 and Order No. 11,970. The outstanding report and all outstanding fees shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Case Nos. MP-2009-068 and MP-2009-088 are hereby consolidated pursuant to Rule No. 20-02.

2. That Certificate of Authority No. 1395 is hereby revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

1. That respondent's 2009 annual report and \$400 in fees shall remain due in accordance with Regulation Nos. 60 and 67.

2. That within thirty days from the date of this order respondent shall:

- a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
- c. surrender Certificate No. 1395 to the Commission.
