This matter is before the Commission on the request of respondent for an extension of time to comply with Order No. 11,947, served April 23, 2009, which assessed a civil forfeiture of \$20,000 against respondent for transporting passengers for hire between points in the Metropolitan District while Certificate No. 1278 was suspended and for failing to comply with a Commission order. Order No. 11,947 suspended all but \$2,250 of the forfeiture on the condition that respondent pay the net forfeiture on or before June 30.

Respondent tendered a \$100 check on June 30 and has requested an extension of two years to pay the remainder of the net forfeiture in monthly installments. Respondent's poor financial condition was noted in Order No. 11,947.

Considering that under the circumstances respondent has made a good faith effort to comply with Order No. 11,947, and considering respondent is otherwise in good standing, an extension of eighteen months shall be granted commencing July 1, 2009.¹ Respondent shall pay the remaining \$2,150 in seventeen installments of \$120 each and one installment of \$110. Each installment shall be due on the first of the month beginning August 2009.
