Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1354 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on September 1, 2009, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 1354 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$50 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 12,132, served September 1, 2009.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on September 2, 2009, and respondent's insurance company tendered a \$50 check on behalf of the respondent on September 8, 2009. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
