Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1450 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent was canceled April 14, 2009, effective May 22, 2009. Respondent's insurance company maintains that a notice of reinstatement was issued April 24 and as proof faxed a replacement endorsement to the Commission on September 21 that respondent's insurance company apparently created on April 24 by logging on to the Commission's e-filing webpage, completing the web form, and printing the result. The Commission, however, has no record of receiving that endorsement prior to September 21, 2009. Coverage under the replacement endorsement expired September 18, 2009.

Order No. 12,157, served September 21, 2009, noted the automatic suspension of Certificate No. 1450 under Regulation No. 58-12, as of May 22, 2009, and the \$50 late insurance fee due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c). The order gave respondent thirty days to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) and pay the \$50 late fee or face revocation of Certificate No. 1450. Respondent filed an acceptable \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on September 22 and tendered \$50 cash on September 21. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
