Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 848 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$500,000 primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on September 18, 2009, without replacement. Order No. 12,154, served September 18, 2009, noted the automatic suspension of Certificate No. 848 pursuant to Regulation No. 58-12, directed respondent to cease transporting passengers for hire under Certificate No. 848, and gave respondent thirty days to replace the terminated endorsement and pay the \$50 late fee due under Regulation No. 67-03(c) or face revocation of Certificate No. 848.

Respondent's \$1 million excess endorsement subsequently terminated September 20, 2009 without replacement. Order No. 12,154 anticipated this by stating that in the event respondent failed to satisfy the requirements of Order No. 12,154 prior to September 20, respondent would have the remainder of the thirty days for replacing the primary coverage to replace the excess coverage.

Respondent filed acceptable \$500,000 primary and \$1 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on September 22, 2009 and tendered \$50 cash on October 5, 2009. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
