This matter is before the Commission on applicant's request for reconsideration of the voiding of authority conditionally granted to applicant in Commission Order No. 11,894 served March 16, 2009. Order No. 11,894 stipulated that applicant would have the full 180 days available under Commission Regulation No. 66, or until September 14, 2009, under Rule No. 7-01, to satisfy the conditions of the grant. Applicant did not fully comply with the prescribed conditions within the allotted time. The conditional grant consequently became void on September 15, 2009. Under Article XIII, Section 4(a), applicant had until October 15, 2009, to file an application for reconsideration.¹

Respondent timely filed an application for reconsideration as of October 15, 2009, but the application does not allege any error on the part of the Commission as required by statute.² The application therefore is denied. However, considering that applicant has fully satisfied the conditions of issuance prescribed in Order No. 11,894, we will reopen this proceeding on our own initiative³ and issue Certificate of Authority No. 1249 to applicant.⁴

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Certificate of Authority No. 1249 shall be issued to Exact Enterprises Inc., 1629 K Street, N.W., #300, Washington, DC 20036-5346.
