Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 214 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated at 12:01 a.m. on April 1, 2010, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 214 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$50 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 12,349, served April 1, 2010.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement later that same day, and respondent's insurance broker paid the \$50 late insurance fee on respondent's behalf on April 7, 2010. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
