This matter is before the Commission on respondent's request for a 14-day extension of the June 4, 2010, deadline for filing a complete 2010 annual report as established in Order No. 12,393, served May 5, 2010. The order noted that Certificate No. 280 stood suspended under Regulation No. 60-03 for respondent's failure to file a complete 2010 annual report within 90 days of the original February 1, 2010, due date. The order gave respondent 30 days to file a complete 2010 annual report or show cause why Certificate No. 280 should not be revoked.

According to Commission Rule No. 7-05: "Except when fixed by statute, whenever by any . . . order of the Commission, . . . an act is required or allowed to be done at or in a specified time, the time fixed or the period of time prescribed may for good cause be extended by the Executive Director . . . ." The deadline for responding to Order No. 12,393 is not fixed by statute, and this is respondent's first request for an extension of time in this proceeding. The extension shall be granted for good cause shown. No further extensions shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the deadline for complying with Order No. 12,393 shall be extended in this proceeding to June 18, 2010.
