This matter is before the Commission on the cancellation of respondent's WMATC Insurance Endorsement effective June 16, 2010, pursuant to written notice filed with the Commission on May 12, 2010.

This proceeding was initiated on February 23, 2010, when the \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated without replacement and Certificate No. 1314 became automatically suspended as a result under Regulation No. 58-12. The suspension was lifted in Order No. 12,353 on April 2, 2010, after respondent filed an acceptable \$1.5 million replacement Endorsement on March 31, 2010. The investigation was continued in accordance with Regulation No. 58-14, however, because the effective date of the March 31 endorsement was April 9, 2010, instead of February 23, 2010.

The March 31 Endorsement was subsequently cancelled by respondent's insurance company on May 12, 2010, effective June 16, 2010, and has not been replaced.

According to Regulation No. 58-12: "Failure to replace a WMATC Insurance Endorsement prior to termination shall result in immediate, automatic suspension of a carrier's WMATC operating authority. The carrier must suspend operations immediately and may not recommence operations unless and until otherwise ordered by the Commission."

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: That respondent shall not transport passengers for hire under Certificate No. 1314 unless and until otherwise ordered by the Commission.
