By letter dated May 24, 2010, applicant was directed to publish notice of this application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District no later than June 7, 2010, and file an affidavit of publication and certain other documents no later than June 21, 2010. Applicant timely published notice and provided an affidavit of publication but has yet to produce the requested documents, including a statement explaining why approving this application would be consistent with the public interest when applicant has not complied with the terms of Order No. 11,858, served February 24, 2009, directing applicant to file an affidavit verifying removal of vehicle markings and surrender Certificate No. 200.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Williams Bus Tours, Inc., for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
