By letter dated April 19, 2010, applicant was directed to publish notice of this application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District no later than May 3, 2010. In addition, applicant was given until May 17, 2010, to file an affidavit of publication and a statement explaining why approving this application would be consistent with the public interest when applicant's owner, Salwa Seedahmed, has not complied with the terms of Order No. 12,135, served September 1, 2009, revoking Ms. Seedahmed's WMATC Certificate No. 733, and giving Mrs. Seedahmed 30 days to surrender Certificate No. 733 and file a notarized affidavit verifying removal of WMATC markings from her vehicle(s).<sup>1</sup> Applicant timely published notice of this application and timely filed an affidavit of publication but has yet to file the public interest statement.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.<sup>2</sup> An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.<sup>3</sup> Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.<sup>4</sup>

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Pantio Medical transportation: LLC for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
