Revocation of Certificate No. 1006)

Certificate No. 1006 has been suspended since May 26, 2010, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 12,412, served May 26, 2010, noted that Certificate No. 1006 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$50 late fee within thirty days. Respondent has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the late fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 1006 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

The \$50 late fee shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1006 is hereby revoked.
2. That the \$50 late insurance fee shall remain due.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 1006 to the Commission.
