Certificate No. 1056 was automatically suspended on June 4, 2010, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 12,428, served June 4, 2010, noted that Certificate No. 1056 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$50 late fee within thirty days. On July 30, 2010, respondent paid the \$50 late fee by check and filed an application requesting voluntary termination of Certificate No. 1056.

The Commission may terminate a certificate of authority under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 10(b), upon application by the holder.

The application shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1056 is hereby terminated, effective this date.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order applicant shall:
 - a. remove from applicant's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 1056 to the Commission.
