Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 206 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million primary and \$1 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated on August 12, 2010, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 206 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$50 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 12,508, served August 12, 2010.

Acceptable \$1 million primary and \$1 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements and a \$50 check were tendered on respondent's behalf on August 13, 2010. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
