On August 30, 2010, in Order No. 12,528, the Commission issued notice pursuant to Regulation No. 58-09 that it was revoking the \$4 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent because the Endorsement is not signed by a person designated for that purpose by an authorized representative of the insurer in a written authorization on file with the Commission in accordance with Regulation No. 58-04(d).

Order No. 12,528, noted that Certificate No. 122 would be automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and subject to revocation pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact, if respondent failed to timely file the necessary replacement WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s).

On August 31, 2010, the Commission received a new \$4 million excess WMATC Endorsement in respondent's name. The new Endorsement is signed by a person designated for that purpose by an authorized representative of the insurer in a written authorization filed with the Commission on August 30, 2010. Accordingly, this proceeding is terminated.
