By application filed September 3, 2010, WMATC Carrier No. 1293 requests that the name on its certificate of authority be changed from Leesburg Limo, Inc., to The LLI Companies, Inc.

Applicant is a Virginia corporation. Records obtained from the Virginia State Corporation Commission indicate that Leesburg Limo, Inc., changed its name to The LLI Companies, Inc., as of June 24, 2010. Applicant has submitted a copy of a certificate of good standing issued by the Virginia State Corporation Commission in applicant's new corporate name. Applicant has also submitted the original Certificate No. 1293 issued February 28, 2007.

Under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 10(b), the Commission may amend a certificate of authority upon application by the holder. Simple name change requests may be granted on good cause shown.¹ For good cause shown, the application shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That upon applicant's timely compliance with the requirements of this order, Certificate of Authority No. 1293 shall be reissued to The LLI Companies, Inc., 407 Alleghany Avenue, Staunton, VA 24401-3302.

2. That applicant may not transport passengers for hire between points in the Metropolitan District pursuant to this order unless and until applicant's certificate of authority has been reissued as amended in accordance with this order.

3. That applicant is hereby directed to present its revenue vehicle(s) for inspection and file the following documents within the 180-day maximum permitted in Commission Regulation No. 66: (a) evidence of insurance pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 58 and

Order No. 4203; (b) an original and four copies of a tariff or tariffs in accordance with Commission Regulation No. 55; (c) a vehicle list stating the year, make, model, serial number, fleet number, license plate number (with jurisdiction) and seating capacity of each vehicle to be used in revenue operations; (d) a copy of the for-hire vehicle registration card, and a lease as required by Commission Regulation No. 62 if applicant is not the registered owner, for each vehicle to be used in revenue operations; and (e) proof of current safety inspection of said vehicle(s) by or on behalf of the United States Department of Transportation, the State of Maryland, the District of Columbia, or the Commonwealth of Virginia.

4. That the approval of amendment herein shall be void and the application shall stand denied upon applicant's failure to timely satisfy the conditions of reissuance prescribed herein.
