Order No. 12,525, served August 30, 2010, revoked the \$2 million primary and \$3 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent effective September 29, 2010. The endorsements were revoked because they were not signed by a person designated for that purpose by an authorized representative of the insurer in a written authorization on file with the Commission as required by Regulation No. 58-04(d).

An acceptable authorization letter and an acceptable replacement endorsement were filed on September 1 for the \$3 million excess of \$2 million coverage layer. Commission staff require additional time to evaluate the acceptability of an authorization letter filed on September 22 with regard to the \$2 million primary coverage layer.

For good cause shown, the revocation effective date stipulated in Order No. 12,525 shall be extended to October 30, 2010, pursuant to Commission Rule No. 7-05.¹

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the effective date of the revocation of respondent's \$2 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement is hereby extended to October 30, 2010.

2. That Certificate No. 14 shall be automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and subject to revocation pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact, if respondent fails to timely file the necessary replacement WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s).
