Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 444 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million primary and \$5 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated on October 1, 2010, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 444 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$50 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 12,566, served October 1, 2010.

Respondent filed acceptable \$1 million primary and \$5 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on October 21, 2010, and tendered a \$50 check on October 26, 2010. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
