On August 30, 2010, in Order No. 12,525, the Commission issued notice pursuant to Regulation No. 58-09 that it was revoking the \$2 million primary and \$3 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent effective September 29, 2010. The endorsements were revoked because they were not signed by a person designated for that purpose by an authorized representative of the insurer in a written authorization on file with the Commission as required by Regulation No. 58-04(d).

Order No. 12,525, noted that Certificate No. 14 would be automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and subject to revocation pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact, if respondent failed to file the necessary replacement WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) prior to the revocation effective date specified in the order.

The September 29 effective date was later extended to October 30 by Order No. 12,561, served September 28, 2010.

As of October 7, respondent had filed acceptable \$2 million primary and \$3 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements. Accordingly, this proceeding is terminated.
