The Commission issued Order No. 12,669 on December 20, 2010, dismissing this application on the grounds that a required supporting statement purported to have been signed by applicant was not signed by applicant and was not under oath. It is now clear that these findings were in error.

Applicant explains that she printed her "signature" on advice of Commission staff. Whether the advice was in error or applicant's understanding of the advice was in error it is clear that applicant is in fact the author of the statement in question. Under the terms of the application form all statements submitted by applicant are deemed submitted under oath.

Under the circumstances, it appears Order No. 12,669 was issued in error. Order No. 12,669 shall accordingly be rescinded and the dismissal vacated.¹
