Case No. MP-2010-089

Certificate No. 1065 was revoked in Order No. 12,661, served December 17, 2010, pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to pay a \$50 late fee under Regulation No. 67-03(c). The order noted that the late fee would remain due. Respondent subsequently paid the late fee and filed an application for reconsideration of Order No. 12,661.

Under Title II of the Compact, Article XIII, Section 4(a), an application for reconsideration of a Commission order must be filed within thirty days of its publication and state specifically the errors claimed as grounds for reconsideration. Respondent timely filed the application for reconsideration as of January 3, 2011, but the application does not allege any error on the part of the Commission. The application therefore is denied.

However, considering that respondent has paid the late fee, we will reopen this proceeding on our own initiative and reinstate Certificate of Authority No. 1065, provided that to prevent circumvention of Regulation Nos. 60-01 and 67-02, respondent shall file a 2011 annual report and pay the 2011 annual fee within 30 days of the date of this order.<sup>1</sup>
