Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1428 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum. Under Regulation No. 67-03(c), \$50 is due and payable upon the failure of a carrier to timely file an acceptable WMATC Insurance Endorsement.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent expired on March 8, 2011, and has not been replaced. Certificate No. 1428, therefore, is automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12 and may be revoked if respondent fails to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) and pay the \$50 late fee within 30 days.

In addition, respondent shall have 30 days to tender the outstanding annual report and \$150 annual fee that were due January 31, 2011, as well as the \$200 in associated late fees now due under Regulation No. 67-03.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That respondent shall not transport passengers for hire under Certificate No. 1428, unless and until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

2. That within thirty days, respondent shall file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s), submit a 2011 annual report, and pay the sum of \$400 by check or money order, or show cause why Certificate No. 1428 should not be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.
