Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1509 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million primary and the \$500,000 excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated on February 15, 2011, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 1509 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$50 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 12,732, served February 15, 2011. Respondent was also directed to tender its overdue 2011 annual report, pay its overdue 2011 annual fee, and pay the late fees resulting from its failure to tender its annual report and annual fee on time.

Respondent filed acceptable \$1 million primary and \$500,000 excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on February 22, 2011, and tendered the outstanding annual report and all outstanding fees on March 14, 2011. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
