Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1517 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million primary and \$500,000 excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated on February 15, 2011, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 1517 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$50 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 12,736, served February 15, 2011.

Respondent filed acceptable \$1 million primary and \$500,000 excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on February 22, 2011, and tendered a \$50 check on March 14, 2011. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
