Applicant, CSL LLC, holds Certificate No. 1240 under the trade name Double Decker Tours. Applicant has filed an application to add three additional trade names to its certificate. The proposed trade names are: 1) Big Bus Tours; 2) Big Bus DC; and 3) Big Bus Washington DC. The application is supported by proof of registration of each of the new trade names with the District of Columbia Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs.

Under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 10(b), the Commission may amend a certificate of authority upon application by the holder.

The application shall be conditionally granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That upon applicant's timely compliance with the requirements of this order, Certificate of Authority No. 1240 shall be reissued to CSL LLC, trading as Double Decker Tours; Big Bus Tours; Big Bus DC; and Big Bus Washington DC, 6318 Chillum Place, N.W., Washington, DC 20011-1404.

2. That applicant may not transport passengers for hire between points in the Metropolitan District pursuant to this order unless and until a certificate of authority has been reissued in accordance with the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant is hereby directed to present its revenue vehicle(s) for inspection and file the following documents within the 180-day maximum permitted in Commission Regulation No. 66: (a) evidence of insurance pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 58; (b) an original and four copies of a tariff or tariffs in accordance with Commission Regulation No. 55; (c) a vehicle list stating the year, make, model, serial number, fleet number, license plate number (with jurisdiction) and seating capacity of each vehicle to be used in revenue operations; (d) a copy of the for-hire vehicle registration card, and a lease as required by Commission Regulation No. 62 if

applicant is not the registered owner, for each vehicle to be used in revenue operations; (e) proof of current safety inspection of said vehicle(s) by or on behalf of the United States Department of Transportation, the State of Maryland, the District of Columbia, or the Commonwealth of Virginia; and (f) the original Certificate No. 1240 issued November 16, 2007.

4. That the grant of authority herein shall be void and the application shall stand denied upon applicant's failure to timely satisfy the conditions of reissuance prescribed herein.
