By letter dated February 1, 2011, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and given until February 15 to file a number of supplemental documents, including a new page 4 of the application bearing a "pen-and-ink" signature to replace the page 4 submitted without an original signature. Applicant faxed a new page 4 to the Commission on February 15, but the original has not yet arrived.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Exquisite Limousine Service LLC for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
