Certificate No. 1646 has been suspended since January 31, 2011, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 12,710, served January 31, 2011, noted that Certificate No. 1646 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$50 late fee within thirty days. Respondent has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the late fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 1646 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

The \$50 late fee shall remain due. In addition, in accordance with Commission Regulation Nos. 60 and 67, respondent's unpaid \$150 annual fee for 2011, unfiled 2011 annual report, and another \$200 in late fees, \$100 for the unfiled report and \$100 for the unpaid annual fee, shall also remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1646 is hereby revoked.
2. That the 2011 annual report and aforementioned \$400 in fees shall remain due.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 1646 to the Commission.
