By letter dated April 5, 2011, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to file within 14 days a statement explaining why approving this application would be consistent with the public interest when applicant has not filed a statement verifying cessation of operations as of November 12, 2009, in compliance with Rule No. 28. Applicant has yet to respond.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Lucky Star Limousine and Shuttle Services, LLC, for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
