Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1725 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on April 1, 2011, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 1725 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$50 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 12,791, served April 1, 2011. Respondent was also directed to pay a \$100 late fee for failing to timely file a complete 2011 annual report.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on April 5, 2011, and tendered a \$50 check on April 20, 2011, in payment of the insurance late fee and a \$100 check on April 26, 2011, in payment of the annual report late fee. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
