This matter is before the Commission on applicant's request for reconsideration of the voiding of authority conditionally granted in Commission Order No. 12,586, served October 15, 2010. The order directed applicant to present its vehicle(s) for inspection and file certain documents within the 180-day maximum permitted by Commission Regulation No. 66. The order stipulated that the grant of authority would be void and the application would stand denied upon applicant's failure to timely satisfy those conditions. Applicant did not meet the 180-day deadline, and the grant became void on April 14, 2011.

Under Article XIII, Section 4(a), applicant has until May 16, 2011, to file an application for reconsideration.¹ Applicant timely filed an application for reconsideration on April 25, 2011, but the application does not allege any error on the part of the Commission as required by statute.² The application therefore is denied. But because applicant fully satisfied the conditions of the grant by the May 16, 2011, deadline for seeking reconsideration, the Commission may reopen this proceeding and issue applicant's authority.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Certificate of Authority No. 1657 shall be reissued to National Veterans Transportation, LLC, trading as Express Medical Transporters of DC, 1530 Caton Center Drive, #C, Baltimore, MD 21227-1512.
