The application in this proceeding was conditionally approved in Order No. 12,668, served December 20, 2010. The order prescribed certain "conditions of issuance" and stated that upon applicant's timely compliance with those conditions, Certificate of Authority No. 1777 would be issued to "Fortune Inc., trading as Alpha Rides". According to the certificate of good standing issued by the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation and filed in support of this application, applicant's legal name is "Alpha Fortune Inc."

The certificate of authority conditionally approved in Order No. 12,668 has not been issued yet because applicant has not satisfied the conditions of issuance. If it is to be issued correctly, the clerical error in Order No. 12,668, must be corrected.<sup>1</sup>

Under Title II of the Compact, Article XIII, Section 3(a), "The Commission shall perform any act, and prescribe, issue, make, amend, or rescind any order, rule, or regulation that it finds necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act." (Emphasis added).

Consistent with applicant's proof of identity, Order No. 12,668 shall be amended to provide: "That upon applicant's timely compliance with the requirements of Order No. 12,668, Certificate of Authority No. 1777 shall be issued to Alpha Fortune Inc., trading as Alpha Rides, 9127 Edmonston Terrace, #301, Greenbelt, MD 20770-4559."
