By letter dated May 5, 2011, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to file no later than May 19, 2011: 1) a statement explaining the relationship between applicant and Deasse Transportation Service, Inc.; 2) a statement describing applicant's relationship to Joachim Madou; and 3) a current list of applicant's officers, directors, and members. The letter cautioned applicant that failure to address these issues would result in delay or dismissal of the application. Applicant has yet to respond.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Medicare Transportation M and D L.L.C. for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
