Holiday Tours, Inc., has filed an application to add the trade name "Holiday" to Certificate No. 1765. The application is supported by proof of registration of the new trade name with the Register of Deeds in Randolph County, North Carolina, where applicant's principal place of business is located.

Under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 10(b), the Commission may amend a certificate of authority upon application by the holder. The application shall be approved.

Normally, the issuance of an amended certificate of authority is conditioned on the applicant presenting its vehicles for inspection, principally for the purpose of demonstrating compliance with the Commission's vehicle marking requirements, and filing certain documents, including a WMATC Insurance Endorsement. Applicant has filed a new WMATC Endorsement that displays the trade name Holiday, and applicant recently demonstrated compliance with the Commission's vehicle marking requirements and filed the other requisite documents in connection with the application for operating authority that resulted in the issuance of Certificate No. 1765 on April 19, 2011.<sup>1</sup> The evidence of applicant's compliance with the Commission's vehicle marking requirements and other documents filed by applicant in that proceeding shall be incorporated by reference in this proceeding pursuant to Commission Rule No. 22-05, and Certificate No. 1765 shall be reissued this day in the name of Holiday Tours, Inc., trading as Holiday.
