Certificate No. 529 was automatically suspended on May 3, 2011, as a result of respondent's failure to file an acceptable annual report for 2011 pursuant to Regulation No. 60-01 and pay a \$100 late fee pursuant to Regulation No. 67-03(a). Order No. 12,838, served May 3, 2011, gave respondent 30 days to cure the deficiencies in respondent's annual report and pay the late fee or face revocation of Certificate No. 529. Respondent cured the deficiencies in the report on June 20, 2011, but respondent has yet to pay the \$100 late fee.

Certificate No. 529 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with Commission Regulation No. 67-03(a) and Commission Order No. 12,838. The late fee shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 529 is hereby revoked.
2. That the \$100 late-annual-report fee shall remain due.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 529 to the Commission.
